Dear Vanessa

My name is Anne-Marie Stilianos. I am the eldest daughter of Philip Stilianos and eldest granddaughter of the late Erini Stiliano. I am situated at 18 Todd Court, Croydon, Victoria 3136. My father has been conferring with me re the will and estate of my grandmother Erini Stiliano (deceased).

My grandmother wrote the will as is because she knew that my father's siblings had received gifts in the past and my father had not. I do not appreciate my Uncle Gary's comment that my sisters and I needing financial help may unwittingly be accepting stolen property. The will of my late grandmother may not specifically mention the Greek land but it does state that "whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated". My understanding would mean that it does include foreign assets as it says wheresoever situated.

I am aware of the situation and arguments re the land in Greece. It appears to me according to the correspondence (exhibits) that my dad is entitled to ALL the land titles in Greece as the titles supposedly gifted to his siblings fail as they had not been transferred legally and if his siblings wish to contest it they now have to bear all costs themselves.

I understand that there was a hearing held last Monday 26th February 2007 at 3.30pm. Could you please let me know as to what the outcome was of that hearing. I spoke to my father last night in Greece as he had not heard anything as yet. I am involved in a roundabout way as we (meaning my sisters and I) are named in the will as beneficiaries should my father pass before he receives his inheritance so we are endeavouring to assist my father to protect the estate as well.
